



Dr. Kim was born in South Korea. He was a missionary and church planter in Ecuador between 1989 and 2001 before coming to the USA. In 2000, he met his wife Juhee (Rebecca) in South Korea and married her in Ecuador in 2001. Dr. Kim holds a Master of Arts degree from Concordia University in Irvine and Pastoral Certification (M. Div equivalent) degree from Concordia Seminary in St. Louis and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Houston Graduate School of Theology. Dr. Kim is currently serving as President and Lead Pastor at Glocal Mission based in Houston. The vision of Glocal Mission is to raise up one million disciple makers for the task of the Great Commission in the United States and around the world by 2031. Under Pastor Kim's leadership, more than 50 churches are being planted in the USA and around the world and thousands of pastors and leaders are being trained in places like Honduras, Nicaragua, Ecuador, South Korea, India, China, Brazil, Paraguay, Argentina, Costa Rica, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Mexico, USA, Kenya, and many others. For 9 years from 2007 to 2016, Dr. Kim served as Mission Director at LINC Houston. He has also been serving for over 9 years on the Board of Mission Administration for Texas District of LC-MS. Dr. Kim also serves as adjunct professor at Concordia University Irvine, CA and Concordia Seminary St Louis, MO. For more information go to:
